

Are you Engaged in your Child's Learning?

Part 3: Create a Good Homework Environment

*There are two important things you can do to get the most out of home learning:
Build your child's confidence and supporting them to learn independently.*

- ✓ Ask your child every day what they learnt at school or what they found interesting or fun in their day.
- ✓ Let your child know you think it's important they do well at school.
- ✓ Be available to help if your child has questions. Make it a positive time you share together.
- ✓ Create a special space for study to make home learning a calm and organised experience.
- ✓ Rules about homework are good to have but it's important to avoid confusion by pushing children to do more, or expecting them to do less than the school asks. If you're not sure ask your child's teacher.
