Agenda Item 1

Round Table Feedback Discussed

Agenda Item 2

School House Colour Names

Steve and Kate have been working with Jodie to come up with appropriate Darkinjung names around the below themes.

Green House will be named after the Darkinjung word for Trees/Leaves/Shrubs and will have a native animal mascot from the trees, for example a Possum (students to possibly decide).

Yellow House will be named after the sun/sky and will have a mascot that flies, for example the Kookaburra. Red House will be named after the earth/ground/dirt and their mascot will be a ground animal, for example a kangaroo.

Blue house will be named after water/the sea/the creek and will have a mascot which lives in water, for example a platypus.

Once the words are selected, there is a complicated process of making sure they are appropriate and then they need to be approved by the Aboriginal Land Council. We understand this is a lengthy process, but we are committed to doing it correctly as these names will be a Legacy to SJF.

Agenda Item 3

Uniform, specifically long sleeve shirts

- Marcel said the decision to remove them was by Cowan & Lewis directly and not the school. This was a stock decision, most likely because of the low demand during home-based learning in Winter over Covid.
- Marcel will call C&W to see if we can get long sleeve shirts back.

- Marcel will also meet with current supplier to discuss issues brought up in this meeting.
- There will be a notice in the newsletter from Marcel next week further clarifying the uniform situation.

- Uniform discussion will roll over to the next meeting after we have more clarity from CSBB and Cowan & Lewis. We will also hold a special advisory meeting later in the year to have a more in-depth discussion about the uniforms as a whole moving forward.
- Year 6 shirts, we are looking into getting a new supplier. Kate will contact a local company Hip Pocket to see if they are able to accommodate our tradition of having our year 6 students design their shirts.

Miscellaneous

- Award Communication was brought up by Talia. Some parents have missed seeing awards as they weren't made aware by class teachers.
- Communication "should be" as follows. Teacher will call parents directly for Growing in Faith Award. Compass notification will come through via text and email for class awards.
- Leadership team will make sure teachers are more on top of communication and remind teachers of the correct communication.
