In my bag I will pack my fruit break, drink bottle, recess, lunch and hat.








Sometimes we will sit on the floor to learn with our teacher.

Sometimes, I will have special lessons with other teachers.


I will have a lesson in the library each week. If I bring a Library bag, I can borrow a book to take home for the week.
